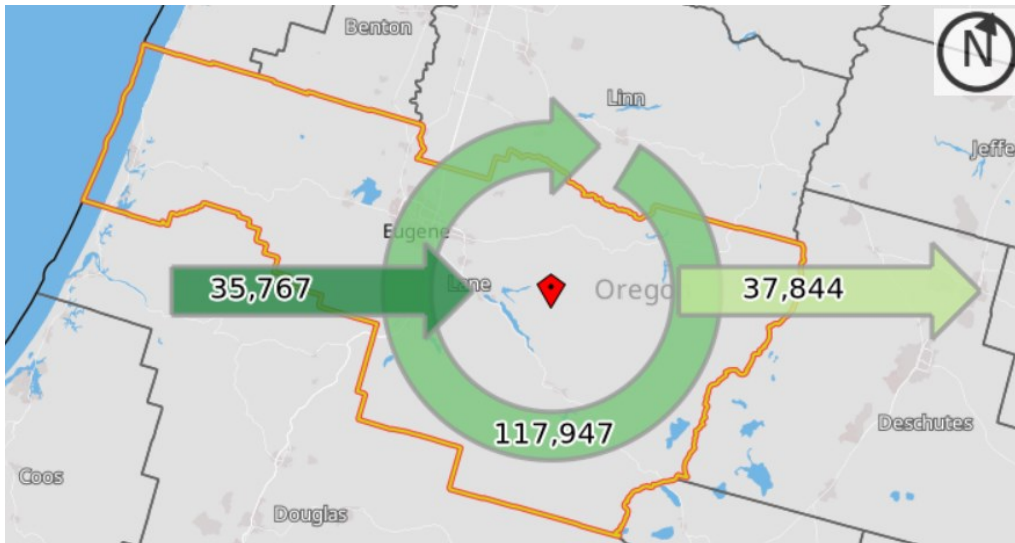


LANE COUNTY ECONOMIC INDICATORS

Topic of the Month: The Census Bureau OnTheMap tool relates household info to employer location to explore worker flows. In Lane, about the same proportion (30%) live outside the county and work here as live here and work outside the county. About 118,000 workers both live and work in Lane.
